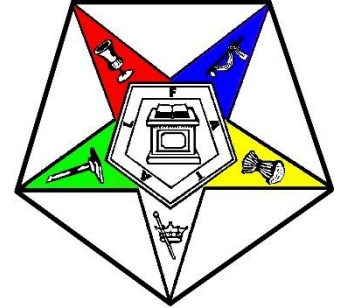




## Grand Chapter Utah Order of the Eastern Star
